### **WE NEED YOUR SENIOR MEMORY PHOTO COLLAGE BY MAY 29TH!**

We are asking for a **MEMORY COLLAGE** of your son or daughter to be displayed at the Grad Night Party. Possible photographic themes include pictures of your graduate involved with sports, hobbies, friends, or a pictorial history. Copy the original photographs and then **you assemble the collage**. Enlarge or reduce the collage to fit on a 8 1/2" x 11" piece of paper. Kinkos or Staples and many other printing businesses can easily do that for you. The finished collage should be on regular bond paper, or photo paper, photos on one side only, and **printed in color or black and white**. Do not laminate the collage or mount it on cardboard or any other material. **We will mount each collage and label it. Print your graduate's name clearly on the BACK.** Use as few or as many photos as you like. See samples enclosed.

**Be sure your graduate is not left out!** Students love to see their pictures and those of their friends. This gives them a chance to reminisce before they go their separate ways. Remind your senior **Grad Night is the last night they will be together!** Encourage them to attend. Once they're there, they will really be glad they came!
